The ideal candidate has a CPA, both public accounting and experience in smaller company environments (tech/engineering strongly preferred), where he/she has owned it all. This role will be responsible for ensuring the accuracy of our accounting books, financial statements, maintaining robust internal controls and supporting the company's accounting & financial objectives.
